ORDER:

Delay in filing the reply is condoned. The reply is taken

on record. The Misc. Application No. 43 of 2025 for delay in

filing the reply is disposed of.

2. Learned advocate for the appellant submits that the

appellant has four bank accounts and he seeks defreezing of one

of the bank account. He submits that there is about Rs. 35,000/-

in the said account. The bank account details of the said

account are as under:-

Canara Bank (current account)

Alfa Surgical & Co.

Account No. 2433201001140

Branch : BTM 2nd Stage

3. Shri Vyom Shah, learned advocate for the respondent

submitted that, in the event this Tribunal were to consider the

interim prayer, the appellant may be put on terms and also be

directed to furnish the details of the bank accounts of all the

noticees.

4. We note that by the impugned order, a penalty of Rs, 1

lakh each under Section 15EB and 15HB of the SEBI Act, 1992

and Rs. 5 lakh under Section 15HA of the Act, and in all a sum

of Rs. 7 lakh has been imposed.

5. We direct defreezing of aforesaid bank Account No.

2433201001140 subject to deposit of Rs. 50% of the penalty

amount, namely, Rs. 3.5 lakhs within two weeks from today. If

the said amount is deposited, the same shall be kept in an

interest bearing account by the respondent. The Misc.

Application No. 187 of 2025 for stay stands disposed of.
